CHECKLIST



Follow these simple tips to stay fire safe while caravanning.

- Check your smoke alarm is working
- Keep a fire extinguisher and fire blanket near the exit
- Turn off gas bottles and check fittings
- Regularly maintain your caravan ensuring its electrical system are in good working order.
- Pack portable radio for bushfire updates
- Turn off non-essential electrics and batteries
- Have a fire escape plan and make sure everyone understands it

SAFETY TIPS



Wherever your travels take you, have a fire plan.

- Always build campfires a safe distance from your van
- Always fully extinguish campfires before going to sleep
- Never leave matches or lighters around children
- Keep looking when cooking and practice safe outdoor cooking
- Only charge devices on hard surfaces, never on your bed
- Avoid smoking or using candles inside a caravan.
- Clear all exits of obstructions
- If a fire starts: get out, stay out and dial 000 (Triple Zero)
- Use the Hazards Near Me app to keep up to date on any nearby bushfires or floods.
